**FRIDAY, September 2nd: Track Closed All Day**

**PARKING**–Trailer and RV parking will commence at 12:00 pm. Due to the lay out of the facility at COQMRA, members will assist you to park. Any vendors needing parking places please contact the COQMRA club prior to arriving.

**FUEL**–The designated fuel stop is the Speedway, 720 US Highway 42 NE right after you exit 70. It is located across from Wendy's on the right hand side. Purchase 89 OCTANE! Methanol will not be provided and it is the handler's responsibility to provide their own and be prepared for on track re-fueling.

- ❖ Handler's Meeting will follow Qualifying.
- ❖ Lower Mains to follow Handler's Meeting
- ❖ Time Limits in effect for lower mains.
- ❖ *Novices will transfer!*
- ❖ No warm up prior to races-ROLL & GO-If driver goes into pits-car will be placed on tail.
- ❖ 3 charge yellows.
- ❖ A Main Races will follow lower mains –Time limits TBA as well as intermission as needed.
- ❖ 1 Minute Warm Up for A Mains.
- ❖ QMA TECH ENFORCED.
- ❖ AWARDS-Fast Time, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, in A Mains.  
All Novices to receive award regardless of place.

***Notice- If a heavy class driver weighs 110 lbs. or lighter after qualifying, the driver will be weighed again and asked to remove ALL of their safety gear. THIS DOES INCLUDE SUIT, helmet, shoes, and gloves. BE PREPARED! You can find this procedure in the rule book page 45.***

**9:30AM Sign Ins Closed-** Late entrants wishing to sign in enter the designated closing time & before the end of that entrant's particular class's qualifying, entry will be accepted. Please note- Entrant will receive a NO TIME.

**10:00AM PRACTICE & QUALIFYING**  
Junior & Senior Stock, Light & Heavy Mod., Jr. Animal, Light & Heavy World Formula, Light & Heavy B, Light & Heavy AA, and Junior Half.

**Race Format for Sunday is the same as Saturday with this exception-** Region 4 mandates 2 races between each AA race: therefore please refer to the posted race order for any changes!!!

**4 cars constitute a class-** If there are less than 4 cars signed in for any class, those cars will receive practice, qualifying and a green, white, checkered (at the RD & Tracks discretion) for the A Main. Points & trophies will be awarded accordingly.

**SIGN IN FEES- NOVICES \$ 25 OTHERS-\$30 per class**

### **SAFETY CHECK**

All cars MUST have a current year R4 safety decal affixed to car. It is the responsibility of the handler, and only the handler to ensure a safety decal is affixed to the car. If you need a decal then you MUST bring your car to the designated safety director for safety inspection.

**All Novices** will have to be safety checked at ALL Championship Series Events and will NOT receive a decal.

Cars will be checked for a safety decal at the scales after qualifying & after the races. Any car found without a safety decal will receive a NO TIME. Any car not having a safety sticker after their race will receive a DQ. All cars are subject to random safety checks throughout the year.

**\*\*\* Effective 2011, right side tires used for the A-main must have been previously used and marked. Tires will be marked after qualifying. \*\*\***

From the West -take I 70E to exit 79 US 42 (Plain City) turn towards London (fuel stop and hotels are on the right past the TA Travel Center)

From the North-take I 75 S to US 23 S to US 42 S towards London.

From the East- take I 70 W to US 42 exit 79 (Plain City)

We recommend that you use the fuel stop's address to map quest the track as it makes it easier.

**Directions to the track from fuel stop-42 SW to OH 38 turn right at the light onto Elm St /Oh 38 track entrance is .4 mi on the left. (8 miles from fuel stop to track)**
